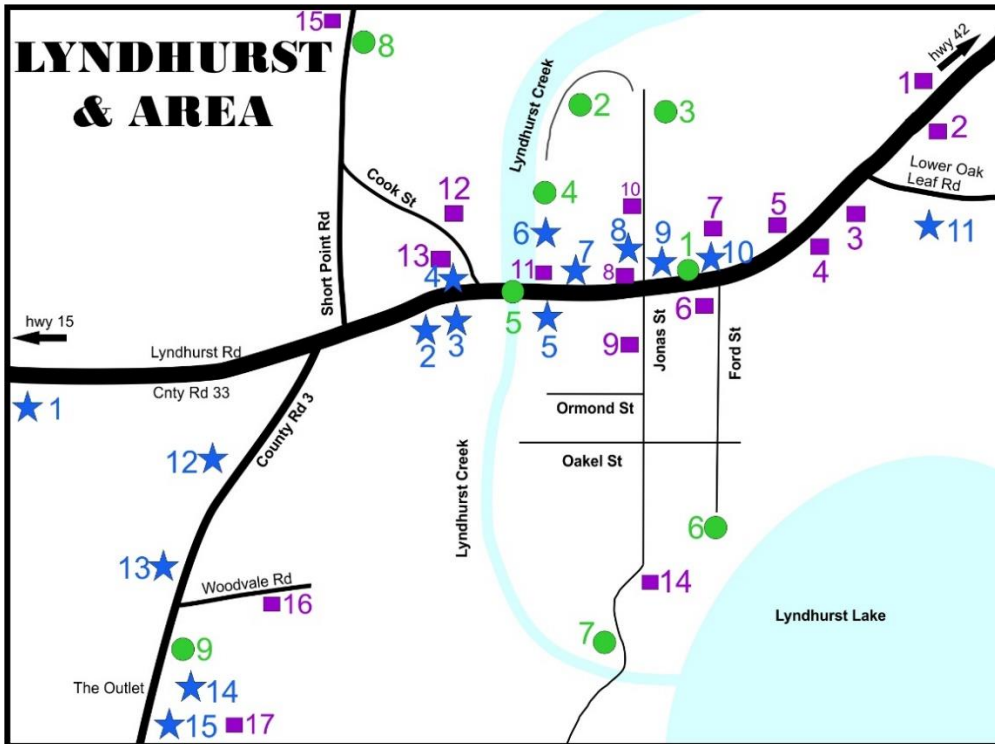

SIX HUBS WITH ART IN ACTION – all within a 10 minutes drive of Lyndhurst!

HUB – 169 Lyndhurst Rd Drive up the laneway to behind the house to find an oasis with a pond surrounded by art.

1. **Up-cycled Metal Art, Gong Mediation & Singing Bowl Demonstrations** - Noah Graham, Siri Sat Kaur (Andrea).

2. **Alpaca Products & Demonstrations** – presented by Round House Alpaca, from source to finished product. Barb Sheach.
 3. **Quilting** – displays and demos by the Stone Bridge Quilters.
Music & Inspiration – performance & song writer's workshop. Audience participation is encouraged. Pat Johnson, Tao Hipwell, Erika Lamon.
TEA ROOM – take a break while you enjoy the music. Tea, Coffee & Sweets.
 4. **Painters** – on display in the Love Blacksmith Shop built in 1887. A chance to see inside this historic building while viewing local painters' works. Weather permitting, artists will be painting onsite at this scenic spot at the Lyndhurst Creek. Valerie Spence Hounsell, Jacquie Kelly, Phil Chadwick, Joan Hubbard.
 5. **Adult Painting Class Demo** – presented by Fun Art Paint Parties, painting class demonstration. Parnie Nolan.

 6. **Hiking with Donkeys Info Session** – presented by Berry Homestead Farm, interactive information session about the traditional way of traveling with donkeys. Donkey milk soap for sale. Annick Rousseau.
Local Farm to Table Producer – presented by Stone Bridge Sweet & Sauce Co. Preserves, sauces and baking for sale. Talk directly to the producer. David Tye.
 7. **Local Painter** – at Peter's Post, refreshments and lunch available. Peter Kordos.
 8. **Fabric Artists** – displays and demos of rug hooking, knitting, weaving, crocheting. Jane Griggs, Elaine Horemans, Patricia Marcus, Nicole Wright, Phyllis Beale. (note: side door of library)
 9. **Fabric Artists** – presented by Sliabhan Custom Apparel, sewing, clothing design. Irene Davelaar, Danielle Schinborn.
 10. **Local and International Artisan work for sale** – the Green Gecko. (**designated tour info centre**)
Canada 150 Painted Paddles – a display of canoe paddles turn artwork created to commemorate Canada's 150th anniversary.

HUB – Long Point School House : 3410 County Rd 3

12. Descendants of Daniel O'Connor and Bridget Trainor, pioneer settlers at Long Point (1830), will be showing their artistic talents at the Long Point School. Visit the restored schoolhouse and be sure to take a turn ringing the old school bell!

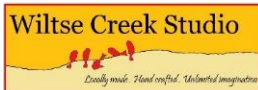

Local Attractions – art installations, historic sites, places to find local information and naturally beautiful spots.

1. **The Plaid House** – art installation by the Lyndhurst Rejuvenation Committee. 432 Lyndhurst Rd.
2. **Lyndhurst Creek Waterfront Trail** – from Furnace Falls Park to Jonas St Park.
3. **Jonas Street Park** – playground, gazebo, entrance to waterfront trail.
4. **Furnace Falls Park** - public washrooms, dock, canoe/kayak launch, boat launch, picnic tables, benches, gazebos, bike racks, historic plaque, entrance to waterfront trail.
5. **Lyndhurst Historic Bridge** – oldest stone bridge in Ontario.
6. **Public Access to Lyndhurst Lake** - dock and paddling dock for launching canoes and kayaks.
7. **Carding Mill Mini Park** – look out & bench on Lyndhurst Creek, historic plaque.
8. **Kendrick's Park** - sandy beach, swimming, pavilions, playground, barbecue facilities.
